Mortgage Banker

Mortgage:

 A type of loan that a homeowner takes out to buy a house, or a business takes out to buy a building, and then pays back the lender over a period of time, usually 15 to 30 years

Job Description:

- Market the business to attract new borrower customers (for example, homeowners or business owners) who wish to borrow money to purchase homes or buildings, and meet with these customers
- Process loan applications
- Investigate borrower customers and their ability to repay the loan, also called "due diligence"
- Guide borrower customers through the loan process, and discuss the various loan type options and the best one for their needs
- Negotiate loan terms with borrower customers
- Close loans, and lend money, so borrower customers can purchase their homes or buildings
- Oversee loan re-payment
- Help borrower customers get better terms over the life of their loans, also called "refinancing"
- Ensure compliance with government rules and regulations on loans and mortgages

Types of Mortgage Bankers:

- Residential makes loans to people to buy homes
- Commercial makes loans to businesses to buy buildings

Education Needed/Other Requirements:

- College associate's degree (2 years) or bachelor's degree (4 years)
- Experience in closing sales, and/or experience in some type of financial industry
- Need to take and pass national and state licensing exams and get licenses

Skills/Personality Traits:

- Strong mathematical and analytical skills
- Knowledge of government rules and regulations
- People skills; outgoing
- Motivated: a self-starter
- Results oriented; detail oriented

- Certain level of education, type of degree, license, and/or certification may be needed to own certain businesses (for example, the owner of an engineering company needs to have a college degree and a license in engineering)
